First it is my wish and will that all my just debts that I may have and my funeral expense be paid out of my estate.

Second, I give, bequeath and devise share and share alike among my three sons, Edward, Theodore and Frederick Julius my blacksmith shop consisting of wagons, carriages, tools, fixtures, iron and wood now situate at No 2028 Market Street in the city of St Louis and State of Missouri.

Third I give, bequeath and devise to Suzzie Michel wife of my son Henry Michel deceased the sum of five dollars.

Fourth I give, bequeath and devise to my grand son Alfred Michel the sum of five dollars.

Fifth I give, bequeath and devise to my grand daughters Suzzie and Hermine each the sum of five dollars.

Sixth I give, bequeath and devise to Maria Michel wife of my son Hermann Michel deceased the sum of one dollar.

Seventh in consideration of the affection and kindness my grand daughter Kattie Reitz has shown me and out of the affection, esteem and regard I bear towards and feel for her, and the services she has rendered me I give, bequeath and devise to her the sum of five hundred dollars.

Eighth I give, bequeath and devise to my daughter Margaretha Reitz the sum of five dollars.

Ninth in consideration of the affection and kindness Adam Reitz husband of my daughter Margaretha has shown me and out of the affection, esteem and regard I bear towards and feel for him, the services and labor he has rendered me and for the amount of money I owe him, I give, bequeath and devise to him the sum of about four thousand dollars that he owes me and forever release him of the same, so that he will not be indebted to my estate after my death and that the note and papers that I hold against him be turned over to him at once after my death.

Tenth that after all my debts and funeral expenses shall have been paid and the special bequests mentioned herein shall have been satisfied then my estate whether real estate or personal property then remaining I give, bequeath and devise share and share alike among my children Margaretha Reitz, Edward Michel, Frederick Julius Michel, Theodore Michel to them and their heirs forever.

Eleventh I hereby appoint Adam Reitz husband
of my daughter Margareth Executor without giving
security as such Executor of this my last will and
testament.
